

WPWP Continuity: Advanced Institute for Recent Fellows

How will you transform the teaching of writing in your classroom? Introducing the Advanced Institute for Recent Fellows! Utilizing principles of action research, the Advanced Institute will hold five workshops over the school year. At these workshops, fellows will: 1) design implementation plans related to the teaching of writing and develop lessons in support of their plans; 2) gather and share student samples from their lessons; 3) analyze and interpret student samples; 4) plan for further revision of their lessons; and 5) share their results with the WPWP community. Five, three-hour workshops will meet on weekends and/or late afternoon-evenings from September 2010 to May 2011. Dates will be scheduled with accepted fellows. All fellows who complete the Advanced Institute will receive 20 ACT 48 hours and a \$500 stipend. Fellows may also register for up to 3 graduate credits at the University of Pittsburgh. Tuition and fees for graduate work apply. This Advanced Institute is reserved for fellows from the 2007-2010 classes and is limited to 12 participants.

How to apply:

All interested fellows must submit an Advanced Institute application form and a letter describing a new or revised writing strategy they wish to implement in their classroom. *Applications are due by September 15, 2010.*
