Call for Teachers Young Writers Institute Summer 2009, July 6-17

WPWP Fellows are needed to teach in YWI this summer. Teachers are needed for grades 4-8 and 9-12 on the Oakland Pitt campus. If you are enthusiastic about teaching in a “community of writers where everyone writes and each voice is valued,” then consider applying for this unique experience. Teachers receive a salary of \$1100 for preparation, thirty hours of teaching during the two-week program, and preparing student work for publication by the Writing Project. An additional stipend of \$100 will be paid for attendance at a required Saturday training session to be held on the Pitt campus on May 9. Teachers are hired by the University as part-time temporary employees, and required deductions are withheld.

Teachers are paired for collaborative teaching with another Writing Project Fellow or a teacher/writer from the Creative Writing Program of the University of Pittsburgh, Department of English.
